**APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

The course is aimed at:

- Young Mongolian professionals from private and public sectors
- Development of skills in economic and financial analysis

Participants should:

- Have had advanced skills in finance and economics or have completed equivalent studies, or have equivalent experience
- Have at least three years of relevant professional experience in public or private institutions or a university or a research institute dealing with the above-mentioned areas
- Be in a position to use and disseminate the information and knowledge acquired during the course
- Have full working knowledge of English
- Have high skills of Windows operation system and statistical package
- Be able to take leave from post for 2 weeks to be available for the course.

In addition, proven competencies such as communication abilities and an aptitude for teamwork and information sharing are prerequisites, so as to maximize the benefits of the course for the sponsoring organization. It would be highly desirable for participants to remain in relevant positions for a sufficient time after the course so that the skills and knowledge gained are disseminated to the fullest at their workplace.

- A brief statement of no more than 1 page in English, stating your competencies and motivation for this training course

Applications must be submitted by the applicant or the sponsoring institution before the **deadline of June 5, 2006**.

Your institution/employer must pay the course fee of US\$ 50 (fifty US Dollars) and lodging and meals for the entire period of two-week course, upon the confirmation for your selection for the course.
